Report – 5th International Diabetes Summit (Virtual) 2021

The 5th International Diabetes Summit 2021 was organized virtually by Chellaram Diabetes Institute from **12th March (Friday) – 14th March(Sunday) 2021**.

Due to the on-going COVID pandemic and resultant restrictions on gatherings and travel, we conducted the IDS 2021 conference virtually.







The abstract submissions were from leading institutions in the country. The Chellaram Foundation Diabetes Research Awards were given, one for Basic Sciences and another for Clinical Sciences. Runner up candidates also received awards. A total prize money of Rs. 3,00,000/- was given to the researchers. The idea of these research awards was to foster the spirit of research among scientists and clinicians of India.

One of the exciting sessions in the conference was on type 1 diabetes management, conducted with endocrinologists, diabetologists, dieticians, doctors, diabetes educators and most importantly people with type 1 diabetes. Dr William Rust, stem cell researcher from USA joined in. The topics discussed included mental health in type 1 diabetes as well as DIY artificial pancreas. This particular session, conducted in collaboration with Blue Circle Foundation (which has >3000 members with type 1 diabetes) was streamed live for the benefit of the 5,300 delegates.






